CONTESTANT INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in the 2011 “Little Miss Fun Days” Beauty Pageant. “Little Miss Fun Days” will take place *Saturday, July 23, 2011 at 6:30 PM*, on the Alexandria Fun Days Stage #2. (See attached sheet for further details.)

There will be a non-refundable **\$5 entry fee** per contestant. *Please make all checks payable to “Alexandria Fire Association”.*

Parents & Contestants: The 2011 “Little Miss Fun Days” Beauty Pageant will be held on Saturday, July 23th at 6:30 PM. If parents wish to provide their own transportation/vehicle signage so their contestant(s) can “pre-appear” in the parade, they are very welcome to do so. Although appearance by the newly crowned Little Miss Fun Days in December 2011 during the Christmas Festival Parade is not mandatory, it would be appreciated—the reigning 2011 Little Miss Fun Days can also appear in the 2011 Fun Days Parade.

Contestants must:

1. Be ages 5 – 7 years old
2. Reach 5th birthday by June 30, 2011 but not reach 8th birthday by July 31, 2011
3. Reside in Northridge LSD or attend Northridge Primary, grades K - 2

Judging criteria will be:

1. Stage presence
2. Poise
3. Personality
4. Appearance

Required attire for contestants:

1. Age appropriate regular-length dress; *no semi-formal or formal dresses*
2. Age appropriate flat or chunk heel dress shoes; flat preferred for safety
3. Limited jewelry
4. *No make-up*

Contestants must return the following:

1. \$5 entry fee
2. Contestant’s contract
3. Emcee sheet

Additional Contest Information:

Contestant registration must be **received** by ***no later than Friday, July 16, 2011***. Last minute registrations **cannot** be accepted. *Call (740) 924-7305 with questions.*

Contestants must reside in or attend grades K – 2 in Northridge Local School District.

Contestants must be accompanied by one adult. *Dressing rooms are not available; please have contestants dressed and ready for the contest.*

Contestants have the option of going to **The Village Spa at 3:30** for complementary “Sparkling up!” before the contest including snacks, nails and sparkle!

Contestants and accompanying adult shall report to sign-in table at the #2 *Fun Days Stage* from 6:00 – 6:25 PM; any contestant not checked in by this time may not be allowed to compete. Contest starts promptly at 6:30 PM. Contestant numbers will be assigned at random.

Dress Rehearsal/Pageant Staging:

A brief on-stage dress rehearsal will be held on Thursday, July 15 at 7:00 PM. Contestants should dress comfortably and will be walked through entrances, modeling, where to stand, exits, etc.

The emcee will begin the “Little Miss Fun Days” contest promptly at 6:30 PM.

Contestants are each introduced by the emcee, with fact sheets read while each contestant appears on stage for “modeling”. Each contestant will then undergo brief questioning by the judges. When individual questioning is concluded, the contestant will be seated on stage.

All contestants will remain on stage during judging and announcement of winner; accompanying adults must remain in pageant area until contest is completed. All contestants will remain on stage in a group for winner announcement, awards, and pictures.

Judging/Sportsmanship:

Judging criteria is stage presence, poise, personality, and appearance.

Judging will consist of a three-judge panel chosen by the Alexandria Fun Days Committee. Judges may **not** have relatives in the contest. *Judges may **not** be approached before or during the pageant by anyone affiliated with contestants.*

Score sheets will **not** be given out. The judges’ decision is **final**. *Undesirable sportsmanship from parents and/or contestants, and/or failure to abide by the rules will result in dismissal from the contest.*

Little Miss Fun Days Contestant Contract

RULES FOR "LITTLE MISS FUN DAYS" BEAUTY PAGEANT:

1. Little Miss Fun Days is open only to 5 – 7 year old "misses" in the K – 2 grade range residing in or attending Northridge Local School District.
2. Contestant cannot hold the title more than once.
3. No refund will be given on entry fee.
4. Contestants must be 5 – 7 years old. Contestants shall reach 5th birthday by June 30, 2011 and not reach 8th birthday before July 31, 2011.
5. Contestants shall abide by age-appropriate dress requirements (see 1st page).
6. Contestants must check-in by no later than 6:25 PM; no check-ins after contest line-up has begun. Undesirable sportsmanship during contest from parents and/or contestants will result in contestant disqualification.
7. Contestants are encouraged to "pre-appear" in Fun Days Parade on Saturday.

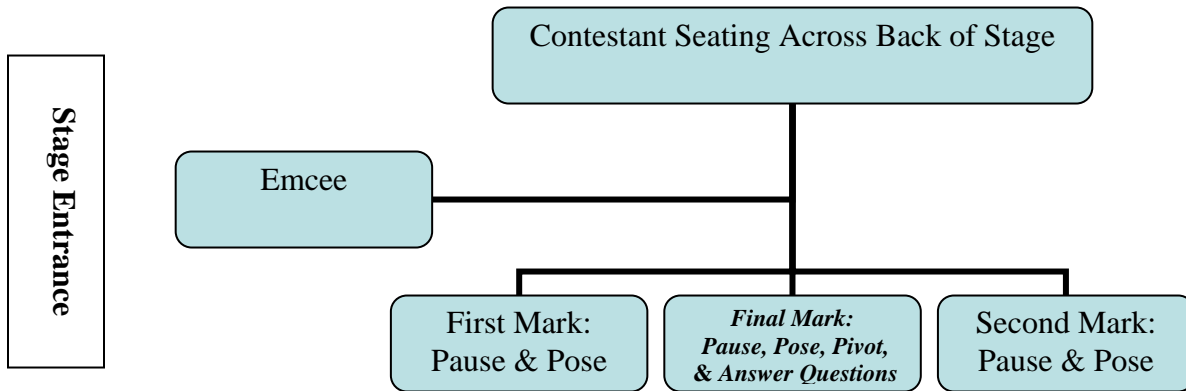

Modeling Phase



Little Miss Fun Days Stage Instructions:

1. Each contestant is individually cued to make stage entrance.
2. Emcee introduces each contestant by number and name.
3. Emcee reads emcee sheet during each contestant's modeling walk.
4. Modeling walk consists of:
 - a. Contestant pauses at first mark at "stage left", and puts right foot's heel to left foot's arch (forms "T")...contestant may pose, smile, wave, curtsy, etc.
 - b. Contestant walks to far end of stage to second mark.
 - c. Contestant pauses at "stage right", forms "T" with feet, and poses, smiles, waves, curtsies, etc.
 - d. Contestant turns and walks to center stage at final mark, pauses, slowly pivots to show outfit, pauses, and poses, smiles, waves, curtsies, etc.—contestant remains at center stage.
 - e. While at center stage, contestant is given microphone to answer questions from three judges; once questions conclude, contestant takes her seat in order at back of stage.
5. Contestants can sit with "crossed ankles" for stage appearance.

Individual results are tallied throughout the pageant. Once final tally is reached, the emcee will *randomly* call all contestants forward to be awarded medallions, flowers, and goodie bags. Once the last *randomly* called contestant is awarded, Little Miss Fun Days will be revealed and crowned.

Judges' Questions

The judging panel will be asking questions after the modeling phase. Question sheets will be handed out during dress rehearsal for parents to take home and review with contestants. Quick, natural responses are appropriate from contestants; please don't over-rehearse responses with the contestants. *Contestants will be asked a practice question during dress rehearsal.*

Winner and Court of Little Miss Fun Days:

Everyone's a Winner!

- 1. Little Miss Fun Days will receive a tiara, scepter, wrap-around sash, bouquet, and trophy; she will retain the title until the following Fun Days.**
- 2. Because the Alexandria Fire Association feels each pageant contestant is a "winner", everyone will receive a pageant medallion, carnation, and goodie bag to take home! NO ONE goes home empty handed!**
- 3. Contestants have the option of "pre-appearing" in the Fun Days Parade on Saturday, July 17 at 11:00 AM; Little Miss Fun Days can appear in the 2011 Christmas Festival Parade and the 2011 Fun Days Parade.**
- 4. The Alexandria Fire Association encourages Little Miss Fun Days to enjoy her title by appearing in any parade or event sponsored by other municipalities or organizations...we are proud to have you represent us!**
